Most chemicals used in your cosmetics have never been evaluated for safety by the FDA or even by the industry-funded Cosmetics Industry Review panel. And some of the chemicals that *have* been tested—and used by companies such as Avon, L'Oréal (Maybelline) and Procter & Gamble (Cover Girl)—are suspected to cause cancer or birth defects.

We put these chemicals on our bodies every day when we use shampoo, nail polish and makeup.

We all expect and deserve safe and healthy beauty products. Help us give the cosmetics industry a makeover that keeps toxic chemicals out of our bodies!

Tell Avon, L'Oréal, and Procter & Gamble to join the nearly 200 cosmetics companies who have signed the Compact for Safe Cosmetics, a pledge to review their ingredients and implement a plan to ensure there are no dangerous and untested chemicals in their products.

And tell the FDA that chemicals should not be allowed in cosmetics products without first being assessed for health and safety.
